Daycare Rules

1. Communicate any questions or concerns to our staff. We like to have a close relationship with our clients in order to provide the best care for your dog. Please report any illnesses, mood changes, absences or concerns to us. We, in turn, will inform you of such things should they become apparent at the daycare.
2. Come on a weekly basis. Coming at least once a week creates a routine that your dog can rely on. Regular attendance increases your dog's trust in us and comfort level. It also creates a predictable environment for all the dogs and this helps to keep the daycare running smoothly.
3. Keep your dog under control during drop off and pick up. Waggin' Tails is a playful atmosphere of happy, controlled, and quiet dogs. In the interest of keeping this order, the dogs must understand that certain types of behavior are not tolerated at daycare. We ask that you teach your dog that, during drop off and pick up they need to be quiet and calm. We know that you love your dog but please make your goodbye and hello in a calm and quiet one so as not to get the other dogs riled up.
4. Dogs MUST be on leash at all times. When walking in the district of North Vancouver it is the law to have your dog on leash. It is important to do this when arriving and leaving from daycare. This ensures that you have control of your dog should there be another dog in the entrance.
5. The daycare is essentially an indoor dog park and, as such, it is not uncommon for dogs to have to "go" on occasion. However, we expect all dogs to have pooped PRIOR to arriving at the daycare. We do our very best to keep Waggin' Tails clean and hygienic. So, please, please poop your dog BEFORE you arrive at daycare.
6. Do not come visit your dog at daycare. It is upsetting to your dog to have you come say "hi" and then leave without them. If you need an update on your dog's well-being, please feel free to call at anytime. And please inform your friends of this rule.
7. Leave sick dogs at home. Although this rule seems obvious, it must be said. Please do not bring your dog in if it is coughing, sneezing, has diarrhea of an unknown cause, etc. Illness spreads easily in a confined space. We are, however, able to accommodate dogs with injuries or non-contagious conditions if they are cleared by a vet for daycare. Your dog must be up to date on all vaccines and flea preventions in order to maintain a healthy environment.
8. Call first to reserve a spot or check for space. We have many clients and many regular clients. If you are a client with a flexible weekly schedule and no regularly reserved days, please call as far in advance as possible to assess the capacity of the daycare.
9. When you have an alternate person pick up your dog, please let us know. Your dog means everything to us. We would never want to place anyone in the wrong hands. So, if you have an alternate person picking up your dog, please phone us with their name, number and description ASAP.

10. Please pick up your dog by 7pm. However, we do understand that things can get in the way of your schedule and make you late for pickup. If this happens please call, let us know and we will accommodate you where we can and within reason. Late fees will apply.
